

## Summer School 2020-21 Programme

The aim of the summer school provision was to deliver a blend of academic education and enrichment activities to incoming year 7 students to support pupil mental health and wellbeing, improving education engagement and transition, making up for the missed education suffered from lockdown and periods of individual or class isolation.

Funding was provided from the Department for Education. The allocation for Nottingham Free School was £35,820 which was used to fund the delivery of a one week programme from Monday 24 August 2021 to Friday 28 August 2021 as follows;
