Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to explain some changes to the structure of the school day from September 2023. Please read the following key questions and answers about these changes:

What are the key changes to the school day next year?

- In order to simplify the school day, for children and parents, we will be moving to one school day finish time for all students.

These will be:

- **2:45pm:** Monday, Wednesday and Friday
- **3:45pm:** Tuesday and Thursday

How is this different from this year's school day?

- Currently, there are staggered finish times, with some year groups finishing at 2.45pm and others at 3.30pm on the same day.

How does this benefit families?

- If you have children in different year groups, you will no longer have multiple collection times.
- With fewer varied finish times, it simplifies the school timetable for all children and their families.

How does this impact my child's timetable and will they still receive the same range of lessons and enrichment opportunities?

- There will still be the same range of subjects and enrichment opportunities built into your child's timetable next year.
