Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s),

As part of Nottingham Free School's continued drive to improve standards in English and maths for all students, we have decided to introduce an online intervention programme called 'Success Maker' to the curriculum. Success Maker is aimed at enabling students to achieve their target levels in both English and maths, using online activities which are linked to their ability levels. Students use computers to work on activities which have been set for them and after 15 minutes, they are given feedback with regards to what they have done well and how they can improve.

Your son/daughter has been chosen to participate in the Success Maker course as we feel it will be beneficial to them. They will now receive two 45 minute lessons of Success Maker each week from Monday 23rd January 2017. These sessions will take place during two of their Spanish lessons. This will mean that they will now have two lessons of Spanish per week and two lessons of Success Maker. This will be for the remainder of the academic year.
