Welcome to Year 10

This letter aims to provide you with an overview of year 10 in order for you to have an understanding of the curriculum, pastoral work and key dates for the year. You will be provided with further details of any specific events nearer to the time.

Pastoral overview

Given the fact that all year 10 students will be completing a week long work experience during this academic year, there will continue be a large emphasis on employability skills. Through PSHCE lessons and tutor time, your child will construct and develop their CV and independently research and source a relevant work experience placement. Students will be developing their employability skills across all subjects this year, equipping them with valuable knowledge and expertise for employment after education.

At Nottingham Free School we have five Attitude to Learning descriptors which all students are working towards; these are 'willing to learn, reflective, determined, resilient and self-motivated'. Students can demonstrate outstanding attitudes in class by being focused, paying attention at all times, producing high quality written work, setting themselves goals to achieve, not giving up and reflecting upon their work and actions in the classroom. As a year group, we will be particularly focusing on demonstrating the characteristics of 'willing to learn' and 'reflective'. These characteristics are vital when aiming to have an outstanding attitude to learning.

Curriculum

Year 10 sees our pupils learn a high proportion of the knowledge and skills needed for each GCSE subject across their curriculum. Given the large amounts of learning that happen in this school year, students need to consistently display an excellent attitude to learning and complete all set homework. It is essential that all pupils practise applying their prior learning by fully utilising in-school study sessions, whilst continuing to enjoy the varied enrichment curriculum that we offer. In year 10, students remain in sets for English, maths and science with other subjects being largely mixed ability. All pupils are challenged and supported in equal measure so that they maximise their potential by the end of year 11. We decide which set a pupil is placed in by using their formal assessment data as well as knowledge of their classwork. We regularly review the settings and make decisions to move pupils when necessary.
