# ALL YOU NEED TO KNOW: Mock Exams 3<sup>rd</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> February

## Which room will I be in for the exams?

- The majority of students will be in the main school hall.
- If you are in one of the smaller access rooms, you will have been told this prior to the exams starting.
- All students will be collected from the dining room and taken to their venue.

## What do I do when I have an exam?

- Each morning check your exam timetable.
- Put all bags and coats into your locker or a friends locker prior to going to the exam.
- Go to the dining hall 10 minutes before the start of the exam.
- Have all exam equipment and a drink ready, and everything else in your locker.

## What do I do after my exam?

- Read your timetable carefully.
- Sometimes you will go straight to your next lesson, other times you may go to wait for a short time in the dining hall.
- Go straight to where you should be, do not walk around school.

## Where do I sit in the exam venue?

- There is a seating plan in each venue
- You must listen carefully to the invigilator, and they will guide you to where your place is.
- **Do not move your name card from the desk or deface/destroy it.**
- Exam invigilators are external and some staff you know – however, they **all** deserve respect.
- **ANY TALKING OR POOR BEHAVIOUR WILL BE REPORTED.**

## What equipment do I need?

- Black pens are essential for all exams
- Pencil & sharpener
- Ruler
- Eraser
- *Calculator (no case)*
- Mathematical equipment (compasses, protractor)
- **Clear pencil cases only!**

All equipment can be purchased from BASE.

## How should I revise during this time?

- Small chunks: a maximum of 40-minute sessions per subject, then take a small break.
- Continue to use revision lists from your subject teachers.
- Revise topics you are weak on, not the things you know.
- Make notes brief – don't copy long paragraphs.
  - Index/flash Cards
  - Trigger words
  - Colour coding
  - Visual cues or mind-maps
- Put these revision aids up around the house
- Knowledge recall: use self-tests, quizzes, teach someone else or have someone test you.
- Use platforms designed to support revision; GCSE Pod, Sparx Maths, Educake
- Application: complete practice past questions/papers.
- **Always get a good night's sleep, never revise late into the evening.**

## DOs and DON'Ts

- **Do be on time!**
- **Don't have phones, smart watches or watches on your person!** Leave them at home or in your bag.
- **Don't communicate inside the exam room!** Hands up to get an invigilator's attention.
- **Do eat before your exam!** No food is allowed in the exam venue.
- **Do go to the toilet prior to the exam!** No leaving to go to toilet in the first/last 20 minutes of any exam.
- **Do leave valuables at home!** You will not be allowed to take your coat and bag with you to your exam desk.
- **Have a drink available to you in the exam!** Clear bottles only, don't have any labels on your water bottles.
- **Have all your equipment ready and in a clear pencil case!** No labels or non-clear allowed.
